

Zone Shoot Guidelines

Each club participating in a NJSTA Zone Shoot shall utilize the SOS*Clays* shoot software.

Squadding: Each club will use the following squads for each event. Pine Valley will use squads 1-19. Ground Swipers will use squads 20-39. North Jersey Clay Targets will use squads 40-59.

Scoring: Each club shall enter scores shot at their club. Consolidated scores for all shoot locations should be displayed at each participating club. Each club is responsible for submitting a shoot report to the ATA.

Tie Breakers: Ties will be decided by these methods, in this order, by sub event scores; reverse run, then longest run. If a tie still exists for two shooters, a coin flip will be used. The shooter with the lowest squad and position will be heads. If a tie exists for more than two shooters, cards will be drawn. The shooter with the lowest squad and position is the first card, and so on.

Money Handling: Each participating club shall either deposit the proceeds in their account and provide a check, or make arrangements to deliver cash, to the NJSTA treasurer for deposit. All funds shall be transferred no later than the first Wednesday following the shoot. Each club shall supply the NJSTA treasurer with a report that defines shoot fees, option fees, etc. The treasurer shall issue a single check for targets and cashing fees to each participating club as soon as possible but no more than 21 days after receipt of the shoot proceeds.

Options: Options payments shall be collected by each club and shall be deposited in accordance with deposit instructions. All options payouts shall be based on consolidated scores. The NJSTA treasurer shall send option checks directly to the shooter after all deposits have cleared.

Trophies: Open and Southern Zone Resident trophies shall be held in the NJSTA building and distributed to member clubs no later than the next NJSTA meeting following the Zone Shoot. Northern Zone Resident trophies shall be held at the Northern Zone host club. Shooters may choose to pick up their trophies at the club where they earned the trophy or make arrangements to pick up their trophy directly from the NJSTA.

Earned Yardage: Each club shall generate, in accordance with ATA requirements, an earned yardage report and shall submit the report to the ATA.
